

Sikh organ donor card design

NHS Blood and Transplant already has a facility for supporters of organ donation to download a digital organ donor card from its website at organdonation.nhs.uk/supporting-my-decision/organ-donor-card/

The downloadable card replicates the design of the plastic card that is sent out to new registrants.

We appreciate that people whose faith is important to them may want to make it clearer when showing their support for organ donation, and may want to highlight the importance of NHS staff discussing their faith beliefs with their family or other appropriate people prior to organ donation proceeding. So we are considering creating some faith-based digital donor cards people can use digitally or print off and keep in their wallet/purse. The proposed digital version (for use on phone screens, social media and other digital channels) would only display the front of the card.
